You can also come and make a Japanese origami paper crane to add to our **'senbazuru'** – a display of 1000 cranes – which we are creating to make a peace wish from Erewash for the world.

How to take part

- Feathers for Peace Dove messages, and crane paper and instructions will be available at Erewash Museum.
- The activity is self-led.
- Everyone is welcome to take part when they visit Erewash Museum.

- You are welcome to make your own cranes in advance and bring them to the museum to be added to the senbazuru.
- Cranes can be any colour. The usual origami paper is @15cm x 15cm.
